The University organizes its academic programs through various Schools of Studies, with the School of Social Sciences being the largest in terms of disciplines, course offerings, and faculty strength. This school oversees eight disciplines: Anthropology, Economics, History, Library and Information Science, Political Science, Psychology, Public Administration, and Sociology. The School of Social Sciences offers a wide range of programs at different academic levels, including Ph.D., Master's Degree, Bachelor's Degree, Post Graduate Diploma, Diploma, and Certificates. The Faculty of History, within the School, specifically offers programs at the Doctor of Philosophy, Master's Degree, and Bachelor's Degree levels in the field of History. The academic offerings of the School encompass a diverse mix of academic, professional, and socially relevant programs. M.A. Programme in History has been developed with a view to provide an opportunity to those learners who wish to go for higher studies in History. The programme would be of great use for the teachers working in schools, personnel working in various institutions associated with history and culture (Museums, Archives, Archaeological Survey etc.), working people in various organizations and all fresh graduates who are desirous of acquiring a Master's Degree in History.

MAHI Program Structure

The M.A. History program at IGNOU adheres to a credit system, requiring students to accumulate a total of 64 credits for the degree, distributed over two years with an annual requirement of 32 credits. Each credit corresponds to 30 hours of dedicated student study time, translating to approximately 240 hours for an eight-credit course. The curriculum departs from traditional specializations in Ancient, Medieval, or Modern History, opting for a thematic approach that offers a comprehensive understanding of major developments in both World and Indian History. The learning materials emphasize the examination of continuity, change, and transitional stages across various aspects such as the economy, political structures, social formations, ideology, and behavior, incorporating the latest research findings into the course content.

In crafting the M.A. History program, particular attention has been given to providing insights into the evolution of historical elements. The curriculum is designed to explore continuity and change in economy, political structures, social frameworks, ideology, and behavior throughout different historical periods. Moving away from the conventional focus on Ancient, Medieval, or Modern History, the program adopts a thematic perspective. With a credit system in place, students are required to complete 64 credits over two years, with an annual commitment of 32 credits. Each credit demands approximately 30 hours of student study, totaling around 240 hours for an eight-credit course. The learning materials are enriched with the incorporation of the latest research findings, ensuring a dynamic and up-to-date educational experience.
